**SUBJECT: SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF UNSERVICEABLE AND OBSOLETE STORES, FURNITURE, EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLES IN THE INSTITUTE**

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This is to notify you that there will be public auctions to dispose obsolete and unserviceable stores, furniture, laboratory equipment, computers and vehicles in the Institute in the month of November and December, 2017. The public auctions are scheduled to take place as follows:-

1. **Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2017** from 10.00 a.m. at **CGHR, Kisian, Kisumu.**
2. **Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2017** from 10.00 a.m. at **CIPDCR, Alupe, Busia.**
3. **Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2017** from 10.00 a.m. at **KEMRI Hq. complex, Nairobi**

Interested purchasers may obtain further details and view the items at the disposal yards/containers located along the KEMRI HQs complex in Nairobi, at CGHR complex in Kisian and at CIPDCR station in Alupe, Busia. Viewing can be arranged with Ms. Purity Mugaruri (0722-205901; 0733-400003; 020-2722541; 020-2713349) or through arrangement with the respective Centers and will be held during normal working hours preferably between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday from 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. #### **Conditions for sale**

1. **Only purchasers with bidding numbers will be allowed to bid for motor vehicles and other items.** Bidding numbers will be obtained as follows:
  - i. Motor vehicles: Deposit of KSh. 50,000.00 (for each vehicle) plus KSh. 1000.00 for catalogue.
  - ii. Other items: Payment of KSh. 1,000.00 (non-refundable) for catalogue

The motor vehicle deposit will serve as part of payment but refundable at the end of the auction with no interest if no successful bid is attained.

2. Items will be sold to the highest bidder on “**AS-IS -WHERE -IS**” basis and will be subject to a reasonable reserve price.
3. **KEMRI does not guarantee** the condition of the items and interested bidders are advised to view and verify the details of the items for themselves;
4. The highest bidder will be the successful bidder and will be required to pay for the item(s) in full at the **fall of the hammer**.
5. Failure to pay the amount of the item in full (but for motor vehicles 25% at the fall of the hammer and balance with within 72 hours) will result in **withdrawal** of the offer and **lose of deposit**. The offer will be made to the second highest bidder.
6. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject or accept any bid without giving any reason whatsoever.
7. Purchasers of obsolete and unserviceable stores will be required to remove items out of the Centers/KEMRI Hq. by close of business on day of auction. Owners of motor vehicles will be required to remove them within 7 days after which each vehicle will attract a storage fee of KSh. 1,000.00 per day which shall be **paid before clearance** is provided to remove vehicle out of the Centre/Institute.
